

Importing P2 Cards into VB104 Avid Media Composer: Steps 1-8

1. Load P2 card into P2 card reader - will show up on desktop as NONAME.
2. BACKUP ALL CONTENTS of EACH P2 card to Backup Drive Folders FIRST - use Copy & Paste.
3. Launch Media Composer Software - be sure all hardware is ON.
4. OPEN MEDIA COMPOSER CLIENT VIDEO PROJECT.
5. Create New Bin or Open existing Bin.
6. FILE Menu - Import P2 - Clips to Bin.
You are now editing off the P2 card's MEDIA - SO YOU MUST create NEW AVID media via Step 7.
7. BIN "Select all Clips" - File Menu - Import P2 - Import Media.
The clip media will be converted to Avid's format and copied to the system media drive.
8. EJECT the P2 cards from the Desktop.
Playback new clips to check that P2 clips media correctly are converted and copied to the system's media drive.

Avid's *Media* are kept in the "Avid MediaFiles" Folder in the 6-TB Corp Media hard drive.

USERS/Shared/AvidMediaComposer/Shared Avid Projects on the Mac Pro hard drive.
